

# Walton County Disc Golf



During the spring of 2010, we will be introducing this Great Lifetime Sport to Walton County. All interested participants will be able to find baskets at the following parks.

- Criswell Park - 9 hole Course
- South Walton – 9 hole Course
- West Walton – 9 hole Course
- Matthews Park – 18 hole Course
- Bold Springs Park – 2 Practice Baskets
- Gratis Park – 2 Practice Baskets
- Meridian Park -3 Practice Baskets
- McGarity Park -2 Practice Baskets

## **How is Disc Golf Played?**

**Object:** Have fun and play the course from beginning to end in the fewest throws.

**Tee Off:** Tee throws must be released from within the designated tee area

**Lie:** The spot where the Disc lands

**Throwing Order:** Lowest score on the previous hole tees first. After the tee off, the player whose lie is farthest from the target throws first

**Fairway Throws:** Must be made from on the lie. A run up and follow through is permitted.

**Putt:** within 10 yards of the target, a player may not step past the lie, when attempting a putt throw.

**Completion of a hole:** The hole is complete when the Disc is in the basket or supported by the chains.

**Out of Bounds :** A throw that lands out of bounds must be played from the point where the Disc went out. One throw penalty.

(Any Disc that Lands on the paved Walking Trails are considered out of bounds, Other out of bounds areas will be marked on Tee signs)

**Courtesy:** Do not throw until players or other park users are out of the range of your throw! **These Discs can be very dangerous**

Putting games may also be played at the practice baskets.
